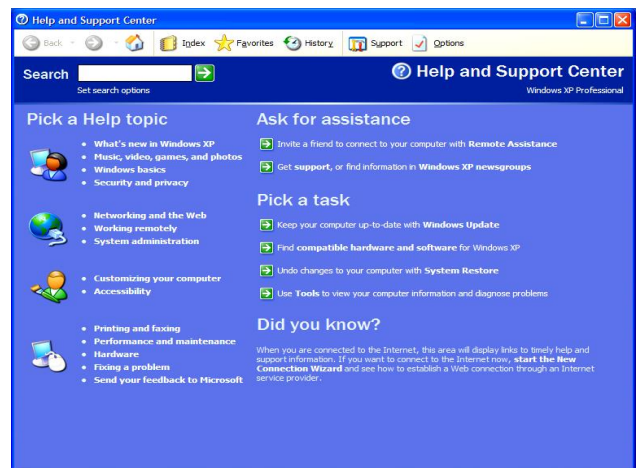

ON-LINE HELP

- All modern software applications relieve users from buying books and other **user manuals** if they want to find help for using their programs.
- Each contemporary computer application or operating system actually provides user with a form of assistance called **On-Line Help**.
- The on-line help is a topic-oriented system that is provided to users in two basic forms:
 - ▶ **Hypertext** form (made by HTML)
 - ▶ **Portable document format** (Adobe PDF)



LAUNCHING ON-LINE HELP

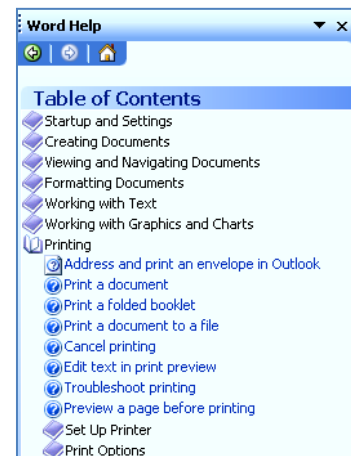
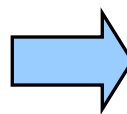
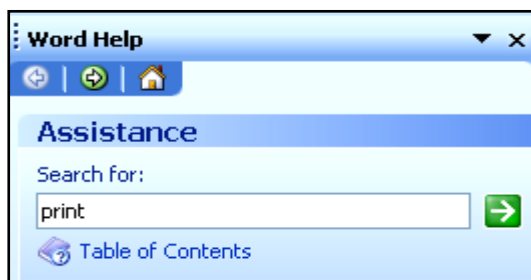
There are three basic ways to launch on-line help in an application:

- ▶ A) in **Menu Bar** select Help
- ▶ B) press the **F1** button 
- ▶ C) Tap the **Help icon**  wherever it is placed.

TOOLS OF ON-LINE HELP

A computer can provide help in three basic ways:

- ▶ **Assistance**
- ▶ **Table of Contents**
- ▶ **Index**



ASSISTANCE

- We write a **keyword** or a **phrase** in a textbox which describes briefly the theme we are looking for.
- After searching, a **table of contents** is appeared which is a list of related contents.
- A user selects the theme that interests him and is driven to new pieces of information in text or hypertext form that called **nodes**.
- Nodes are text files interconnected through **links** similarly to web pages of world wide web.
- A link is always activated by pressing specific words or phrases called **hot words**.

- Hot words are **hypertexts** that are characterized from a different color (often blue) that drive through links to other texts or hypertexts.

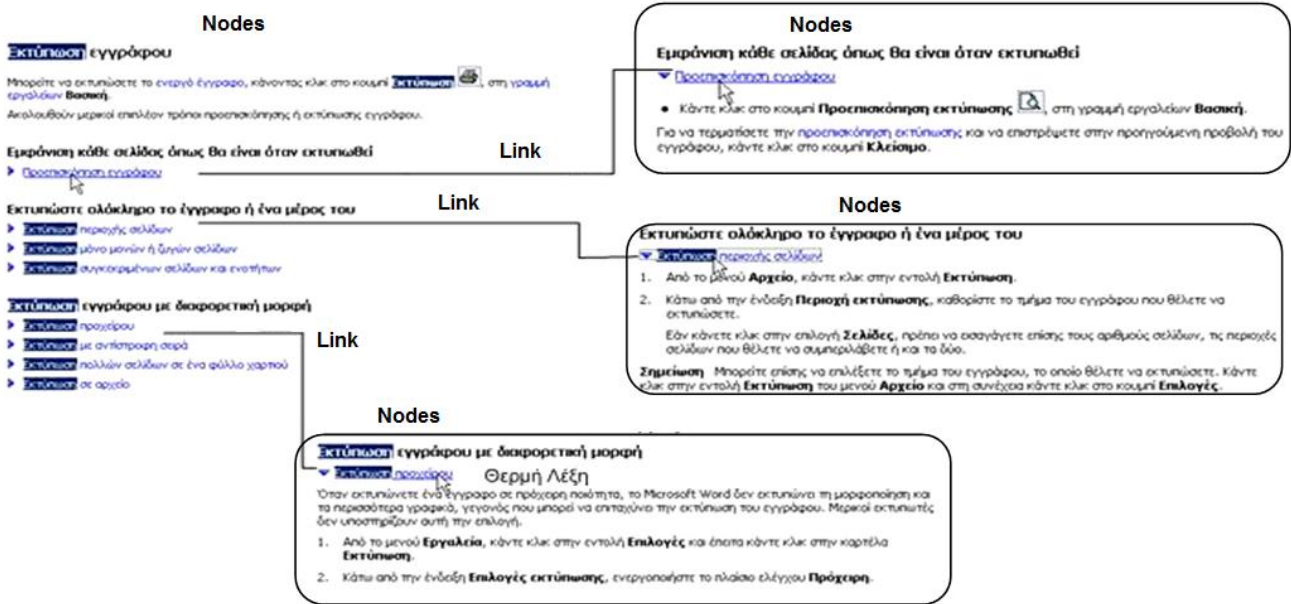
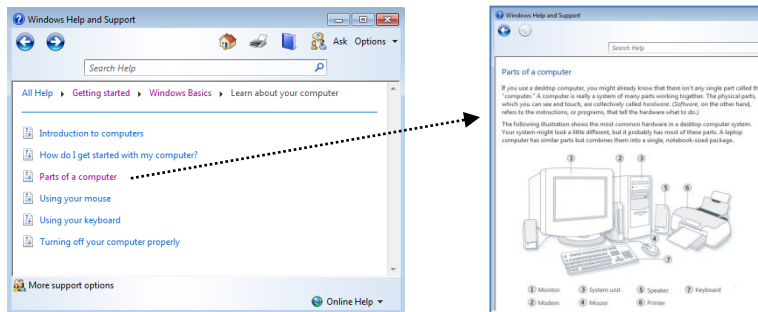


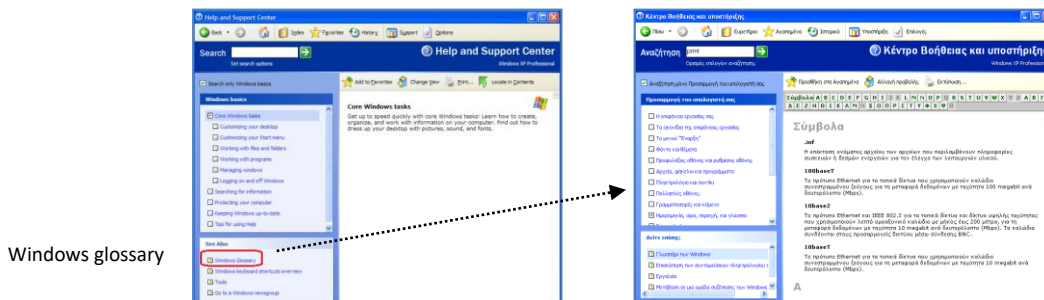
TABLE OF CONTENTS

- It provides user a list of **complete topics** that are organized by categories of interest.
- The user again can select any topic interests him via **hot words** or **phrases**.
- The more hyperlinks a user selects the more detailed information he gathers about a topic.
- A table of contents is a kind of on-line help that is oriented more to novice users.



INDEX (GLOSSARY)

- It provides a **list of terms** alphabetically organized. The terms are both greek or english.
- The index help is one of the basic help tools in **Help & Support Center** of Windows XP.
